



# General Information

- (1) Each day, neighborhood evangelism will consist of various things. Most of our time will be spent doing door-to-door witnessing but we may also do cookouts, block parties or even entire worship services in the streets. The goal is to feed hundreds with food and the Lord's message of hope and plan of salvation.
- (2) In order to spend more time on the streets, the schedule is very different this year and we will be packing sack lunches each day. Please let us know in advance if you have any dietary needs or concerns.
- (3) The daily evangelism will also include special events, gifts and games for the kids of the neighborhoods. Sharing the love and hope of Jesus with children who may never have the opportunity to attend a church is an important part of saving entire families.
- (4) We will use tracts to share the Gospel but we will also be advertising Abiding Temple's Thursday night worship service and our Saturday morning revival with fliers.
- (5) Saturday begins with a neighborhood march that draws people back to the church for a revival service and pancake brunch. We then give out Gifts from the Father (toys, clothes, food, household supplies, etc.) to those in need. If you are interested in donating gifts, please contact Jo Hooper, (214)796-7832 to learn more about what we need and how to help out.
- (6) Terry Western will be in charge of any daily work projects we do at the church or at the Pastor's home. We focus on ways we can practically help the church and neighborhood. Jobs usually include repairing walls, building fences or anything else the Pastor requests. For questions regarding that, please contact Terry at (940)393-1818.
- (7) We may add business visitations, career training classes and other special events as time permits.

# Things to Bring

# Registration

- (1) Total cost for the nine-day trip is \$400, due by July 16, 2011.
- (2) All new participants must be interviewed prior to completing registration. This ensures our team stays unified and that each individual is a part of something they are called to.
- (3) Medical release forms must be completed before we leave.
- (4) Those who cannot make the entire trip can join us in New Orleans for as many days as possible. Cost would be \$50 per day to cover room and meals.
- (5) All participants must be willing to respect authority. Each of us will also be given chores to do throughout the week.
- (6) Youth who come with us must be willing to turn in their cell phones while in New Orleans. Certain times will be designated for them to call home and parents can always contact the leadership if they'd like to talk with their children.
- (7) Executing His Word Ministries will have the option of sending individuals home at their expense if they continue to refuse to follow instructions or submit to the leadership. Unity and obedience are absolutely essential to this mission trip.
